Hardware and software requirements:

- IBM-compatible computer, with a 80386-Processor or higher
- Minimum 10 MB free Hard Disk space
- Minimum 8 MB RAM
- Microsoft Windows 95, 98, NT 4.0, 2000, XP, Vista, Windows 7 or 8 (32 and 64-bit operating systems)
- Adobe Reader

You need administrator rights on your computer to install the software. Quit all running applications on your computer, then start setup.exe and follow the instructions on the screen. Start PST++Questionnaire.exe after installation.

After answering the Questionnaire start the program PST++Evaluation.exe, which allows you to get the Questionnaire results, and to create a graph of the results.

With this software version you will be able to evaluate a total of five questionnaires. After participating in a Church-In-Progress workshop, you will get a different software version, which can evaluate an unlimited number of questionnaires.
